**Registration fee:** € 30,-- for each registered athlete only freestyle the club competition  
 € 20,-- for each registered athlete of the talent parcours  
 € 40,-- for each registered athlete only freestyle (AK7-10)  
 € 50,-- for each entered athlete only freestyle (Novice, Advanced, Youth class)  
 € 60,-- for each registered pair (Basic)  
 € 70,-- for each registered pair (Advanced)

 It is expressly pointed out that this is an entry fee which will not be refunded if the athlete does not appear.

**Eligibility:** The competitions are open only to amateurs who are

- a) belong to a registered club and through this to a German LEV which is a member of the German Skating Union, and
- b) are in possession of a valid sports passport (for national athletes)
- c) meet the requirements for the respective category.

**Participant limit:** There is no restriction on the number of participants under the aforementioned participant eligibility.  
 However, the organizer reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of participants should this become necessary in order to be able to guarantee a schedule.  
 The organizer is entitled to divide a competition into groups according to ISU regulations.

**Judges:** The judges will be appointed by the organizer. All clubs are requested to contact their judges for the BJM. The schedule of judges will be drawn up by Peggy Sonntag, the chairwoman of the judges' committee.

**Schedule:** The schedule will be drawn up after the closing date and sent to all participating clubs as soon as possible.

**Draw:** The initial draws for the competitions will take place on Thursday evening from 16.30 hrs using the official ISU software. The starting orders for the free skates after a short program will be determined in reverse order of the rankings of the short program.

Music will be stored temporarily for the period of time until the end of the competition in order to be able to play it back via computer for the competition.
